
National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) Student Satisfaction Survey Analysis Report

For this Survey, a Questionnaire consisting of Twenty One (21) Questions with regard to Student Satisfaction on Teaching was prepared and Students have expressed their views regarding Teaching, Quality of Teaching, Opportunities given to Students, Coverage of the Syllabus etc.

The opinions expressed by the Students were shown in a Tabular Form and also in the form of a Diagrams or Graphs.



2. With regard to the Teachers' Preparation for the Class:-



3. Teacher's Ability to Communicate:-



60 percent of the students have expressed that the Institute often takes active interest in promoting Internship, student exchange, field visit and opportunities and 40 percent have expressed sometimes only.



90 Percent of the students have expressed that the teaching and mentoring process provided by the institute significantly and only 10 Percent very well.





90 Percent of the students have expressed that every time Teachers inform about the opportunities and only 10 Percent have expressed usually.



Teacher Feedback Analysis Report


The role of faculty in designing and developing of curriculum is one of the most prominent one in the development of any institution .Teacher's feedback is sought from around 70 faculty members about the curriculum and teaching learning process. As teachers play a pivotal role in designing and implementing the curriculum, the inputs received from their feedback was taken into consideration for further necessary action wherever applicable.

Feedback Analysis


Majority of 80% of the teachers expressed that syllabi taught by them have a good balance between theory and application. Majority of 65% of them strongly agreed the objectives of the syllabi are well defined and 70% of them strongly agreed that the books/journals are relevant, updated and cover the entire syllabi. Majority 80% of them strongly agreed that curriculum is flexible for enrichment, revision and modification based on recent trends and innovative ideas. 100% of the teachers agreed that they have the freedom to adopt new teaching strategies for curriculum.90% of staff also expressed that tests and examinations were conducted well in time with proper coverage of syllabus. 60% of them agreed that availability of books in library is sufficient.75% of the teachers strongly agreed that the environment of the college is conducive to teaching and research. 80% of the staff strongly agree that the college provides adequate opportunities and support to faculty members for upgrading their skills and qualifications. Majority of 60% of them agreed that maintenance of college premises and washrooms are good. Generally 60% of the staff used to own vehicle,20% of them used to public transport and 10% of the staff used to private transport to commute to the college.

They also felt that the books and reference materials in the syllabi prescribed were up to date in nature. They also stated that due weightage for employment opportunities were provided in the course curriculum and they were contented about the fact they enjoy freedom in framing of syllabus.

Feed Back Out come

The majority of parents have given very high ranking for well managed and transparent admission procedure to attract meritorious students. Parents were very satisfied by the security and overall discipline of the college by giving it very high rating. Highest rating was given to the academic atmosphere. There were numerous positive comments on teaching and teacher-student interaction and teachers were described as caring, cooperative, approachable and efficient.

Majority of the parents 90% felt that facilities and Infrastructure of the college is excellent. 100% of the parents expressed that Security and discipline of the college campus was also highly commended. Also 53.8% of them appreciated hostel facilities of the college. An average of 60% of the parents satisfied for cooperation from the administrative staff. 40% of the parents expressed that make direct communication with teaching staff. Also 50% of parents appreciated the career orientation and placement support services offered by the institution and upgradation of soft skills.






Alumni Feed Back On Courses Analysis Report



Analysis of Alumni Feedback on Courses


