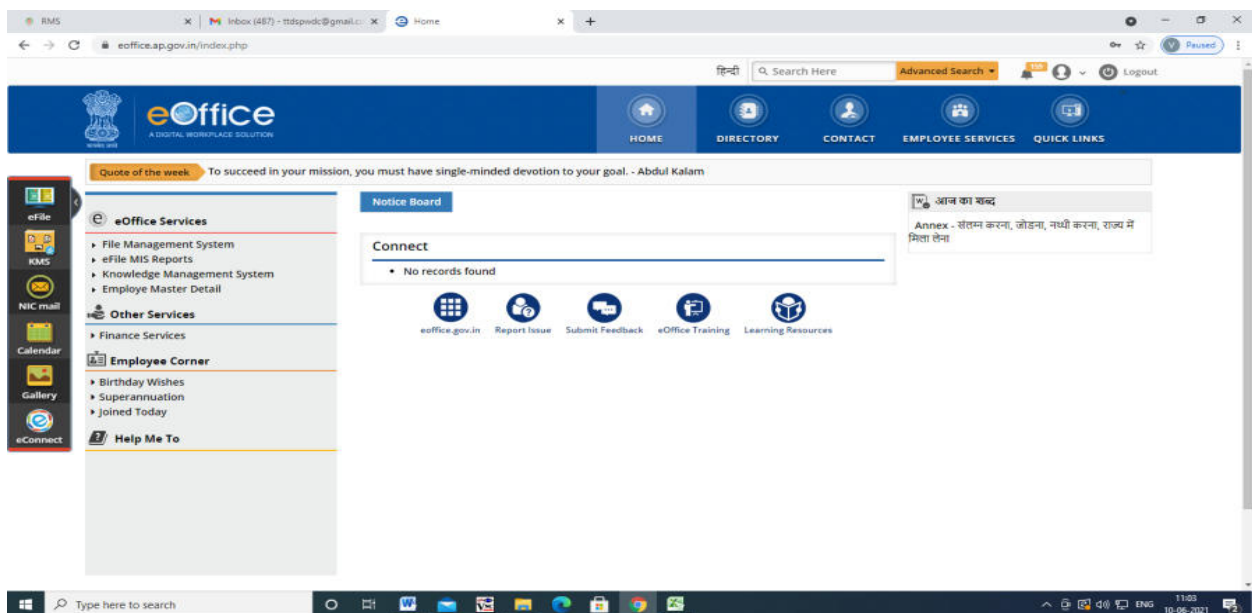

Circulars and other official communications are converted into digital form. The College has implemented Assignment submission by students through electronic via. All the communications to students and parents are through SMS and E-mail.



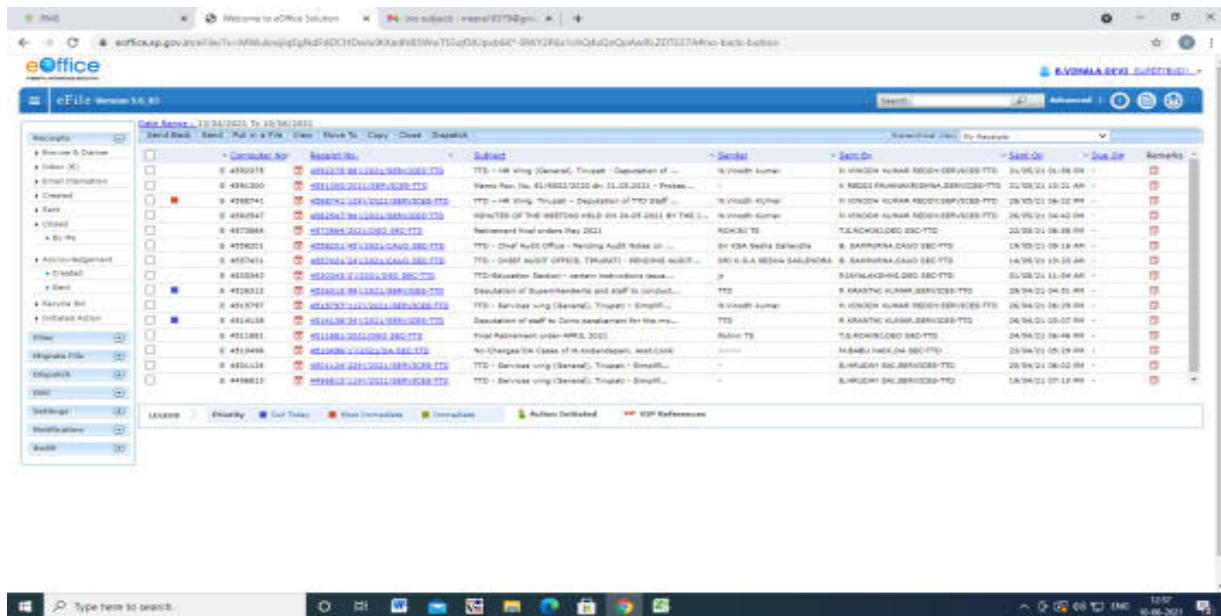
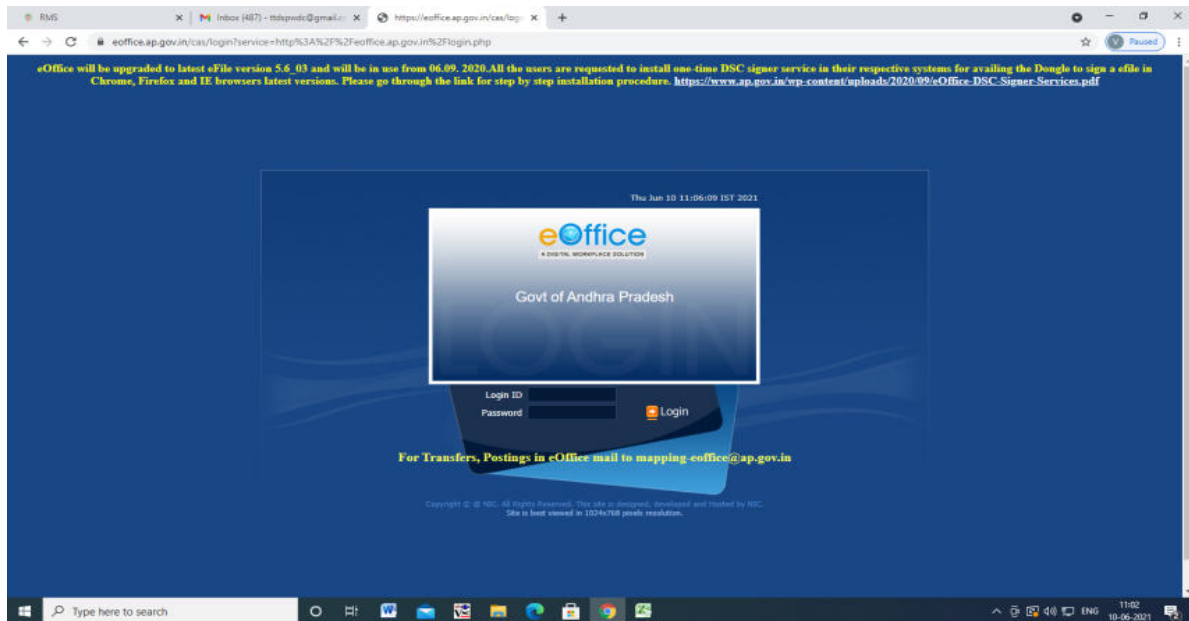


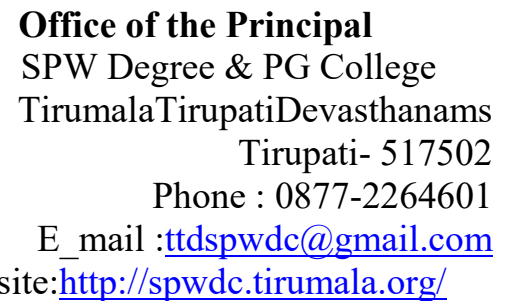
