- 2. On behalf of Samrita Trust, Mr Shaik Meharaz, BA, 100 % blind, preparing for Civils examinations to become IAS officer, demonstrated use of laptop and smartphone by blind students. About 90 blind students attended the demonstrations. Brief on the presentation is attached as Appendix "A".

BRIEF ON DEMONSTRATION BY SAMRITA TRUST TO BLIND STUDENTS IN TTD COLLEGES ON 24 OCTOBER 2017

- Demonstrations. One demonstration was given from 11 am to 12:30 pm in SV
 Arts college for blind students of SV Arts college and SV Junior college. About 50 students attended. Another demonstration was given in SPW Junior college from 3 pm to 4:30 pm, where blind students of SPW Degree college also joined. About 30 blind students attended.
- 2. Samrita Trust. Mr NS Sastry informed that blind students must register as members of Samrita Trust Talking Book library, to receive FREE talking books from Samrita Trust. Talking books for courses donated improved results in courses. Talking books for competitive examinations donated enabled 150 blind students to get jobs. Samrita Trust is working to convince Govts. of AP & T to publish all text books in accessible format and upload them in Sugamya Pustakalaya.
- 3. Laptop & Smartphone. Mr Shaik Meharaz, BCom, a blind person, demonstrated use of laptop and explained what blind students can do with a laptop. He demonstrated reading books in laptop. Blind students can create documents, send and receive emails, buy tickets and items on line and prepare and make presentations in power point. They can also prepare tables in Excel format. He stressed need for all blind students to learn operation of computers with screen reader, NVDA. He appealed to the Principals to teach computer skills and give certificates on computer skills essential for employment. He also demonstrated day to day use of a smartphones by blind students with many apps available. He demonstrated use of smartphones to read e books in English, Telugu and Hindi and also DAISY audio books. @Voice Aloud Reader, Kota DAISY reader, UB reader are the Apps in smartphones to read books.
